As you may know, CPS Energy plans to construct a new high-voltage power line, commonly referred to as the Anderson-to-Westover Hills Transmission Project, in the Westover Hills area of Bexar County. This line is needed to keep pace with rapid customer growth in the area and to improve service to existing customers. It will connect the existing Anderson Substation west of Loop 1604 to the Westover Hills Substation north of Wiseman Boulevard and east of Rogers Road. As a culmination of CPS Energy's Facility General Routing and Siting Process, on May 18, 2009 the CPS Board of Trustees approved the preferred route for this new power line.

Initiated on 2008, the Routing and Siting Process included an open house, a detailed environmental assessment, many conversations with interested customers and a public input session. The project team presented preferred route # 10 to the CPS Energy Board of Trustees at a regularly scheduled Board Meeting on March 2, 2009. After reviewing the comments taken at the Public Input Session and other written comments from interested customers the Board made its determination on May 18, 2009.

An illustration of the approved route is attached. CPS Energy will begin contacting property owners along the approved route in order to gather information needed for timely construction of the power line. Additional project related information is available online at CPSEnergy.com
