Dear CPS Energy Customer,

CPS Energy, your natural gas and electric provider, wants to make you aware of an upcoming project and get your help.

To improve electric reliability in our growing community, we must rebuild a high-voltage transmission line, a portion of which extends from the corner of Edgebrook and Buckeye Streets to an electric substation located at West Avenue and Viendo Street.

All metal, lattice-type transmission towers will be replaced by slender steel monopoles. While most of the poles/structures will be located as closely as possible to the original placement of the old structures, some are likely to move in order to adapt to the changes in the roadways, landscape, etc., since the line was originally constructed back in 1962.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring of 2011. Pre-construction activity such as surveying will begin in early August, 2009. We must trim trees and other vegetation that hinder safety or access for our construction and maintenance crews around these overhead lines. This includes any vegetation growing into the overhead lines or within the safety zone of the overhead lines. Trees and vegetation will be properly trimmed by a CPS Energy contractor.
