SunEdison currently manages more than 300 megawatts (MW) of photovoltaic solar power plants worldwide.

Impact of CPS Energy agreement

SunEdison has entered into a PPA with CPS Energy to provide the utility with 30 MW of solar power from three separate locations across the CPS Energy service territory. Two of the sites are owned by the San Antonio Water System (SAWS) and are within the Dos Rios Water Recycling Center on almost 270 acres of land. The third site is in Somerset, Texas. Each site will produce approximately 10MW of power that will flow into the CPS Energy electric distribution system.

- Construction jobs are estimated to be between 60 and 90 per 10MW facility.
- SunEdison plans to invest nearly \$137 million in this project.
- The project is expected to be online by late 2012.
- SunEdison will open a regional office in San Antonio and is expected to employ 6 full-time employees.
- SunEdison will contribute \$300,000 to create an educational facility, located in San Antonio, for grade school and secondary students. Sun Edison also will collaborate with CPS Energy and the City of San Antonio on research and development with UTSA.
