CPS Energy – UTSA Strategic Alliance Overview

- Focus future research and development efforts on key energy challenges facing the utility, including renewable energy, energy efficiency and distributed technologies and initiatives the utility will use to meet the energy needs of Greater San Antonio.
- Projects will include, but are not limited to, carbon sequestration, smart grid development, renewable energy storage, electric transportation and consumer behavior surrounding conservation and efficiency.



CPS Energy – UTSA Strategic Alliance Terms

- CPS Energy will provide initial funding of \$1 million in Year 1 and \$2.5 million in Year 2, with secondary contingent funding for Years 3 through 10.
- Combined amount not to exceed \$50 million over the next 10 years given:
 - Annual budget approval by the Board of Trustees
 - Appropriate rate support from City Council
- Annual planning process to develop a rolling 2-year work plan.
