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CALL MEETING TO ORDER, INVOCATION AND SAFETY MESSAGE

The WebEx meeting was called to order at 11:31 by Chair Luisa Casso.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the CAC meeting held on May 12, 2021 were approved as read.

BUDGET DISCUSSION

Cory Kuchinsky, Chief Financial Officer & Treasurer and Shannon Albert, Vice President Accounting provided an update on CPS Energy's financial landscape. They discussed the proposed budget for FY 22 and process by which CPS Energy seeks budget approval. They then discussed the potential need for a rate increase, the items for which the additional funds would be used and pointed out that even before the impacts of the Pandemic and Winter Storm Uri the need for an increase in rates was building. Ultimately, a rate increase is not being recommended for approval at this time. CPS Energy will wait to see how the summer months and the legislature play out and whether some of the financial pressures will be eased.

RAC UPDATE

Rudy Garza, Chief Customer and Stakeholder Engagement Officer, provided an update on the Rate Advisory Committee (RAC). The RAC, which is Chaired by Reed Williams and Vice-Chaired by Eloisa Portillo Morales, held its first meeting on May 27 as a hybrid meeting at CPS headquarters. It was primarily an organizational meeting where members got a chance to meet each other and discuss the process for the meetings. He reported that the Committee will meet every other week over the next three months and will be focused on how rates are developed and how CPS Energy recovers costs.

The Committee has been meeting every Friday at 10am and will conclude their meetings June 15.
