Working Group members received an overview of the roles of the PUCT and ERCOT and how they function in relation to the Texas Legislature. The interaction and coordination of CPS Energy's engagement with the PUCT and ERCOT was explained, emphasizing the utility's focus on advocacy, transparency, and legislative alignment. Members were also informed of the various documents available on the PUCT and ERCOT websites. Members offered feedback on opportunities for CPS Energy to leverage the CIC as an extension of its advocacy efforts within PUCT processes and through broader stakeholder engagement and encouraged CPS Energy to provide continued updates on key initiatives. Working Group members commended CPS Energy for its strategic approach to maintaining internal and external stakeholder alignment, monitoring priority issues, and mitigating risks that could impact CPS Energy customers.
