CPS ENERGY COMMUNITY INPUT COMMITTEE

CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT AND CONFLICT OF INTEREST STATEMENT

BACKGROUND: The Texas Legislature exempts public utilities from providing certain competitive information for public disclosure. Information considered competitive, as defined by Section 552.133 of the Texas Government Code and/or by other applicable sections of Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code, is protected from public disclosure. The Texas Attorney General has opined that a municipality's disclosure of confidential information to a municipally appointed Community Input Committee does not constitute a release to the public.

UNDERSTANDING: Therefore, as an appointed member of the CPS Energy Community Input Committee (the "Committee"), I understand that CPS Energy may, on occasion, present the Committee with information that is considered confidential and not available to the general public. CPS Energy will identify the general nature of such information before its presentation to the Committee. Also, as an appointed member of the Committee, I understand that I may not use any information gained in my official position as a committee member to advance or impede private interests. Further, as an appointed member of the Committee, I understand that I shall not grant or secure, or attempt to grant or secure, for any person (including himself or herself) or any entity any form of special consideration, treatment, exemption, or advantage beyond that wherein is lawfully available to other persons or entities. I further understand that I shall not accept, without prior approval from the Committee and CPS Energy, any engagement known to be or contemplated to be in conflict with or adverse to the interests of CPS Energy.

AFFIRMATION: By my signature below, I hereby recognize and acknowledge that CPS Energy may provide confidential information to me, as a Committee member that would not be available to the general public. By receiving this information, I have accepted a duty and responsibility to maintain the confidentiality of that information which is presented by CPS Energy and identified as confidential, and I must not share all, or any part, with any non-Committee member. If my receipt of such confidential information would create, or even appear to create a potential conflict of interest in my responsibilities to CPS Energy and the Committee and my private or personal obligations, I recognize that I must recuse myself immediately from the meeting and not to accept receipt of such information from anyone, including CPS Energy staff or other Committee members. I further recognize that if the potential for a conflict of interest arises after I have obtained information, including confidential information in my position as a Committee member, I shall notify CPS Energy, and I will take all appropriate action to alleviate the conflict of interest or potential conflict of interest. I recognize that violation of this commitment to maintain confidentiality and to avoid or notify CPS Energy of any conflict of interest may result in my removal from the Committee. As an appointed member of the Committee, I understand that by signing and dating this CPS Energy Community Input Committee Confidentiality Agreement and Conflict of Interest Statement, I agree to comply with all terms and statements within this agreement. I further understand that by signing and dating this agreement and statement my obligations regarding the confidentiality of CPS Energy information shall survive the expiration or termination of my term of Committee appointment.
