CPS Energy owns and operates the Calaveras Power Station which includes two power plants [J.T. Deely (ceased operation at the end of December 2018) and J.K. Spruce] that have Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) units subject to regulation under Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 257 (40 CFR §257), Subpart D (a.k.a. the Federal CCR Rule) and Title 30, Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 352 (30 TAC §352), Subchapter H (a.k.a. the Texas CCR Rule), collectively referred to as the CCR Rules. Per the CCR Rules, an annual face-to-face meeting or exercise must be held between representatives of CPS Energy and local emergency responders.

The annual face-to-face meeting or exercise must be held regardless of whether one of the emergency levels has occurred. If an incident defined by one of these emergency levels occurs, then the annual meeting date may be moved to discuss the incident.

This letter documents the annual face-to-face meeting / exercise conducted on October 2, 2025. This meeting was attended by representatives of CPS Energy, San Antonio River Authority, San Antonio Water System, Bexar County Office of Emergency Management, City of San Antonio Fire Department and Office of Emergency Management, Texas Parks & Wildlife Department, IEM, and Republic Services, Inc. This letter must be maintained in the facility's operating record and must be uploaded to the established CCR website.
