Dear Landowner:

CPS Energy would like to inform you of an infrastructure enhancement project that supports electric reliability in your neighborhood. The project consists of replacing an estimated 6.9-mile segment of the Braunig to Highland Hills 138 kV transmission line that crosses your property. This infrastructure rebuild will replace existing transmission line with new transmission line structures and conductors from SE Military Dr. to the Braunig Power Plant.

As a part of this project, CPS Energy has contracted The University of Texas at San Antonio to complete soil sampling within the transmission easement. Soil sampling work is scheduled to begin on July 18, 2022 and is expected to conclude by September 1, 2022.

There will be vehicle traffic through the easement as crews conduct a pedestrian survey with shovel testing where soil sampling will be conducted. We do not anticipate any power outages as part of the soil bore work.
