Dear CPS Energy Customer:

Thank you for allowing us to serve your energy needs. We are reaching out to inform you about an upcoming project in your area. This enhancement to our infrastructure consists of rebuilding existing high-voltage transmission lines to support electric reliability in your neighborhood. We do not anticipate any power outages while the work is being performed.

Our contractor for this project is **Southeast Power Corporation**. Construction is expected to begin around the first week of October 2022. The contractor will be preparing the existing transmission line right of way, installing new foundations, demolishing the existing transmission line towers and wire, and installing new tubular steel poles and new wire. The expected project duration is approximately thirty-eight (38) weeks.

The enclosed brochure contains a detailed project description, as well as a map that illustrates the route of the existing transmission line. The project should have little or no impact on your property. All of the transmission lines and structures associated with this project, including towers and foundations, are located within our easements or public street right-of-ways.
