

**Correction and update to previous public input meeting invitation letter. Please see highlighted area below.**

November 7, 2012

Dear CPS Energy Customers and neighboring property owners:

As you may know, CPS Energy plans to build a new substation northwest of San Antonio and Helotes in Bexar County. The new substation will require approximately 5 acres of property and may require the addition of a short span of transmission line to the existing Helotes-Menger Transmission Line. We propose to start construction in the fall of 2013.

The siting of this substation has been managed through CPS Energy's Facility General Routing and Siting Process, which included an open house, a detailed environmental assessment and many conversations with interested parties. The project team presented a recommended site (please see enclosed map) to the CPS Energy Board of Trustees at a regularly scheduled Board meeting on October 29, 2012. The Board again will consider the site at a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, November 19, 2012.

**Prior to making a final determination, the Trustees will host a public input meeting on the evening of November 13, 2012 to hear customer comments and suggestions about the site selection and associated power line route.**
