

SECTION II

II GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

A. Definitions

Application means a complete Application for a Permit submitted by an Attaching Entity to CPS Energy for the purpose of requesting consent to install a new Attachment, Overlash, Wireless Installation, or Banner Attachment onto or supported by one or more CPS Energy Poles or Streetlight Poles, as appropriate. Mid-Span Installations do not require Applications, but a Notification of Mid-Span Installations (as defined below) instead. While Service Drops are Attachments, Service Drops installed within the Attaching Entity's previously authorized Attachment Space do not require a separate Permit Application to be filed. The above notwithstanding, all such Service Drop installations must be reported pursuant to a quarterly "Service Drop Report," the form for which is provided in Appendix B.

Application Form means the form(s), provided in Appendix B, an Attaching Entity is required to submit to CPS Energy, along with all applicable documents, as part of a complete Application in order to request a Permit. Such forms include the Application for Pole Attachment Permit, Overlash Permit, Application for Wireless Installation Permit, and Application for Banner Permit. ~~A Mid-Span Installation does not require an Application; rather, an Attaching Entity seeking to attach a Mid-Span Installation shall submit the "Mid-Span Installation Notification Form" found in Appendix B, along with all applicable supporting information and documentation.~~

Attachment means (a) each aerial cable together with its associated Messenger cable, guy wire, anchors, and associated hardware, and each amplifier, repeater, receiver, appliance or other device or piece of equipment, whether comprised of steel, aluminum, copper, coaxial, optical fiber, or other media or material utilized to provide Communications Services; and (b) any hardware or equipment identified as (i) a Communications Facility affixed to a CPS Energy Pole utilizing one foot or less of Communication Space, or (ii) a Mid-Span Installation utilizing the same one foot of Communication Space as the Messenger cable to which it is attached. An Attachment occurs whether Attaching Entity's Communications Facilities are connected to the Pole itself or are supported by an Attachment Arm, bracket, support stand, or other support devices. ~~provided however that Overlapping an existing~~

~~permitted Attachment and Service Drops shall not count as separate Attachments.~~ This definition shall not apply to communications wires or facilities installed by CPS Energy for its own internal communications requirements or energy Information Services such as automated meter reading.

Attachment Connection Fee means the total annual rental payment assessed by CPS Energy to each Attaching Entity determined by multiplying [Attachment Rate] x [total feet of Communications Space occupied by authorized number of Attachments for the Attaching Entity, measured in one-foot increments], as described in Appendix H.

Wireless Installation Fee means the total annual rental payment assessed by CPS Energy to each Attaching Entity that owns Wireless Installations determined by multiplying the [Wireless Rate] x [total number of pole-feet occupied by an Attaching Entity's authorized Wireless Installations, measured in one-foot increments], as described in Appendix H.

Service Drop Report means the quarterly reporting of Service Drops installed for which a separate permit was not issued pursuant to Section IV.B.2.(b)(iii), utilizing the form provided in Appendix B.

b) Service Drops

(i) Attachment of Service Drops to Poles Without Permitted Attachments- Where Make-Ready Work is Required. If an Attaching Entity does not have a permitted Attachment on the Pole on which it proposes to install a Service Drop, and the installation will require Make Ready Work for completion, the

Attaching Entity shall follow the Standard Process for Wireline Attachments by submitting an Application and following the relevant procedures applicable thereto.

(ii) Attachment of Service Drops to Poles Without Permitted Attachments Where No Make-Ready Work is Required. An Attaching Entity may install a Service Drop on a Pole, within the Communications Space for which the Attaching Entity does not have an authorized Attachment provided that (A) the installation of the Service Drop does not require Make-Ready Work; and (B) the Attaching Entity submits a corresponding Application for Permit meeting these Standards for approval within thirty (30) days of the end of the calendar month in which such Service Drop was installed. Upon receipt of a properly submitted and complete Permit, CPS Energy shall review and authorize a Permit for such Service Drop that meets these Standards. If upon review the Service Drop is not found to be in accordance with the Standards the Attaching Entity shall undertake all necessary corrections to bring the installation into conformity at its own cost. In the event that the CPS Energy review determines that Make-Ready Work should have been performed to accommodate the Service Drop the Attaching Entity shall pay the costs of such Make-Ready Work.

(iii) Attachment of Service Drops Using Previously-Permitted Attachment Space. The submission of an Application is not required to install a Service Drop on a Pole on which the Attaching Entity already has an authorized Attachment, provided that: (A) the Service Drop is installed within the space authorized for an existing Attachment; and (B) the Attaching Entity submits information on the installation of such Service Drop on the next quarterly Service Drop Report. ~~the Attaching Entity provides notice of such Service Drop pursuant to Section II.F.1 and the Service Drop is installed within the previously authorized space. — Service Drops on Poles for which the Attaching Entity does not have an authorized Attachment may be authorized by CPS Energy, on a monthly basis, provided the Attaching Entity submits a corresponding Application for Permit within thirty (30) calendar days of the Service Drop installation.~~

(iv) Connecting Ground-Based Facilities to Pole. All Service Drop installations where the Attaching Entity is seeking to connect ground-based facilities to a Pole shall use a riser/U-guard and be made in conformance with all CPS Energy ground-to-pole engineering standards including the Riser Installation requirements in Appendix G.
