

POLE ATTACHMENT STANDARDS



Pole Attachment Standards

• Effective: Aug 1, 2016



POLE ATTACHMENT STANDARDS



One-Touch Transfers:

- Only for "Simple Transfers"
 - Simple Transfers: No cutting or splicing needed
- Will require attacher to notify owner of transfer 72 hrs. in advance of transfer
- Will require attacher to notify facility owner that transfer is complete. Owner can inspect within 15 calendar days

POLE ATTACHMENT STANDARDS



Section IV.B.5.b states,

"An Attaching Entity must engage qualified contractors approved by CPS Energy pursuant to a certification program developed by CPS Energy with the input of Attaching Entities."

ONE-TOUCH CONTRACTOR PROCESS



What it is:

- A criteria-driven qualification process open to one or more communication contractors
- Attaching Entities would select from this list and engage the qualified contractor directly

What it is not:

 An RFP process whereby CPS Energy engages a single qualified contractor on behalf of all Attaching Entities



CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION MATRIX AND APPROVAL PROCESS

ONE-TOUCH CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATION MATRIX



- Composed of 4 Sections:
 - 1. Company Background
 - 2. Experience
 - 3. Safety
 - 4. Other

	B. Year to date Osha Rate (RIR)	The YTD OSHA RIR and the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) SIC Code RIR average for the industry.
	C. 3 Year Osha Citation History	Offerors with "willful" OSHA citations may be disqualified. All "willful" OSHA citations must be explained in detail.
	D. Up-to-date copy of safety program/manual	An electronic copy of Offeror's up-to-date safety manual.
	E. Assign a Safety Professional for the work and provide a resume outlining completion of OSHA 30 hour construction safety training.	A statement of Offeror's ability to provide an individual that: i. has completed the OSHA thirty (30) hour outreach training course; and ii. will be responsive to CPS Energy's request for participation in safety events, analysis and/or sessions.




