Question: Is it possible that 56% of the customers in SA are past due? They're more than 30 days past due? Please include the number of customers that are past due


#### **Answers:**

- Dollars:
  - No, the chart below is focused on dollars, not the count of customers. As of March 31, 2021, 56% of the dollars owed by residential customers (i.e., accounts receivable) are 30 days past due.

More than half of the Residential account balances owed are over 30 days past due as of March 2021.



- Average of Current Dollars:




Current amount of accounts receivable (rounded to \$millions)
